INDUSTRIAL CANAL DELIVERIES

Deliveries in the Industrial Canal will be made at the basic HARBOR RATE plus a lock fee of **\$2,341.00**. All standby time at the locks will be at the stated demurrage rate **minus four (4) hours free time**.

DEMURRAGE RATE

Demurrage will be charged for any delays in excess of allowed time which is not the fault of Savage Inland Marine.

Boat: \$475.00 Barge: \$155.00

NOTICE OF DELIVERY

Bunker buyer or Vessel's local agent shall give Savage Inland Marine (SIM) Bunker Scheduler's (Seller's local representative at the delivery port) at least forty-eight (48) hours' advanced notice of each delivery, confirming product, quantities, delivery date, time and location. Where forty-eight (48) hours' advance notice is not given; then SIM Bunker Schedulers shall in normal circumstances use reasonable efforts to make the bunker delivery in a timely manner.

EQUIPMENT ACCEPTABILITY

Once a barge has been deemed acceptable for loading by the customer's loading facility personnel and/or independent surveyor, SIM will be released from any and all responsibility and liability for claims arising out of product quality disputes unless said problems were the direct result of SIM equipment failure or SIM personnel error.

LOADING REQUIREMENTS

No product will be loaded unless the temperature is at least 125 Degrees Fahrenheit at the shore tank. Savage Inland Marine will not be responsible for picking up suction and/ or quality of fuel samples for stems of 50 metric tons or less.

SHIP CONNECTION ARE MADE BY SHIP VESSEL'S PERSONNEL

SIM bunker barges are equipped with a minimum of 70 feet of flow through cargo boom and hose install on the deck. In addition, each boat carries a supply of standard reducers. The demurrage rate will apply for all delays caused by difficult connections requiring extra hose or special reducers in order to make the ship's connection.

PORT TARIFFS

SIM is not responsible for any charges incurred for any dock, port or harbor tariffs.

GOVERNMENTAL DELAYS

Any delays due to government agencies (USCG, U.S. Customs, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers) will be charged at the stated demurrage rate.

LOAD/DISCHARGE LAYTIME

Loading laytime based on 150 metric tons per hour (approximately 1,000 barrels per hour) plus **four (4) hours free time**.

Discharge laytime based on 150 metric tons per hour (approximately 1,000 barrels per hour) plus **four (4) hours free time**.

ABORTED DELIVERY

Aborted delivery rate of \$13,081.00 (flat rate) or \$12.11 per metric ton, whichever is greater.

PUMPBACK FOR RETAINS

Extra charges will begin from departure of vessel until all product is pumped off, at the posted demurrage rate of \$655.00 per hour or \$13,081.00, whichever is greater.

ADDITIONAL LOADING DOCK

All running times to and from additional loading docks, any additional dock hose connection and dock hose disconnection, and any delays by inspectors will be at the posted demurrage rate of \$655.00 per hour. These additional charges are separate and apart from actual loading times.

BARGE TO BARGE TRANSFERS

Per USCG regulations a 4 hour notice must be given to USCG during low River for approval before executing a barge to barge transfer. During high river, there must be a 48 hour notice given. Barge to barge transfers will be at demurrage rate for 2 barges and 1 boat \$810.00/per hour, from hose on until hose is disconnected upon completion of transfer. If a boat is not available the charge will be \$310 for the barges and any shore tankerman fees that will apply.

DEBUNKER RATES

From departure of Savage Inland Marine fleet until return to SIM fleet at our flat rate fee of \$13,081.00 or \$655.00 per hour, whichever is greater.

MISCELLANEOUS SERVICES

All miscellaneous services will be performed at the posted demurrage rate with a 4-hour minimum plus any applicable Tankerman fees.

HEATING

A minimum flat rate of \$315.00 per hour will be charged along with the applicable fuel surcharge when fuel exceeds \$3.00/gallon.

TERMS

Net upon receipt of invoice.
